Here you will find a description of the quality codes.

Descriptions apply to the spare parts that have been put in stock after 17.03.2023

Description of quality codes for metal body parts

Letters describe the quality of the material

NYO = New original part

NYU= New unoriginal part

A= Used but like new in quality

B = Used may have dents and bends but functional.

C= Rust, underlying zinc layer breaking through the paint and sealing problems

D = Hole in the material, can also be holes for original mounted sensor, locks, tow bar etc.

R = Repaired part

The number describes dents, flickers and bends

1= No damage to the part

2= max 3 dents (max. 2,5cm in diameter)

3= More than 4 dents (max 2,5 cm I diameter), dents from 2.5 cm - to a maximum of 10 cm in diameter. The dents are often marked on the picture so you can see how big they are.

4 = Large dents over 10 cm, Flickering, buckling of the material. The dents and bends are often marked on the picture so you can see how much it is.

Bumper and other plastic parts

Letters describe the quality of the material

NYO = New original part

NYU= New unoriginal part

A= Used but like new in quality

B = No scratches in the material, holes or cutouts other than original. May have paint damage/ or be faded.

C= Dents, deep scratches in the lacquered material, not original holes/cuts.

D = Split, cracked, needs to be glued, broken eye, deep scratches in unpainted material

R = Repaired part

Description of quality codes other spare parts

Letters describe the quality of the material

NYO = New original part

NYU= New unoriginal part

A= Used but as new above average

B = Used correspond to year and kilometer medium condition

C= Worn, scratched, but fully functional below average.

D = Defective, damaged or has defects

R = Refurbished part

The numbers describe where og if the spare parts have been tested

1 = tested in own company

2= tested by supplier

No number = not tested

You then combine letters and numbers so that you can have one

NYO – NYO1- NYO2

NYU - NYU1- NYU2
